- Membership is renewable annually with a minimum gift of \$1,000.

#### A Mind Is Society

On July 28th we celebrated our 80th anniversary in Atlanta with supporters, colleagues and students.

**We celebrate because:** Since UNCF was founded in 1944, the organization has raised more than \$5 billion and helped more than 500,000 students not just attend college, but thrive, graduate and become leaders.

We celebrate because: Annually UNCF awards more than 12,000 scholarships worth more than \$70 million and financially supports 37 historically Black colleges and universities (HBCUs).

We celebrate because: Over the past eight decades, UNCF has more than doubled the number of minority students attending college.

We celebrate because: UNCF impact on the growth and development of HBCUs and their students has been unprecedented. Although HBCUs represent just 3% of all higher education institutions, they produce nearly 20% of all African American graduates. Since 1984, HBCUs have awarded minority students more than 1 million associate, bachelor, master's and doctoral degrees.

We celebrate because: The post-college economic mobility rate for Black HBCU students is higher than those Black students attending non-HBCU institutions. The total lifetime earnings for HBCU graduates are \$130 billion.

Dr. Cole has been a catalyst for the work of UNCF and provided outstanding leadership at two UNCF member colleges, Spelman and Bennett. We honor her profound dedication to education, her work and generosity in helping to change the educational landscape and create opportunities for African American students pursuing a college education.


