Improving Community College Completion Outcomes

Accelerated completion

Financial assistance to complete your associate degree, saving you time and money while ensuring students acquire the skills and knowledge needed for success.

• Career-focused pathways Students pursuing careers in finance, health and STEM.

Mentorship and career readiness

AMAUNI

Paired with a Fidelity Mentor, students gain access to workshops and networking opportunities designed to enhance professional skills and expand career prospects.

Personalized guidance

Receive personalized guidance from college success coaches who are dedicated to helping students navigate their educational and career journey with confidence.





The Ideal Applicant

- **Demonstrate** tenacity, drive, resilience and a commitment to their chosen path
- Students who do not have funding to enroll full-time
- Students who may have dropped out but are interested in returning full-time to complete their degree or certificate program
 - STEM, financial services, or health related degree or certificate program. (Ex. Accounting, Financial Management, Personal Finance)
- Students who are seeking to go directly into the workforce upon completion of a community college credential



Opportunity for the Mighty Middle

Application for the 2024-25 award year

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



At least 18 years

U.S. citizens or have legal permanent resident status High school diploma or GED

Minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 or above Enrolling or currently enrolled with no more than 32 earned credits

(up-to one year of credit in accordance with institutional guidelines) Must be working toward their first degree or certificate Pell eligible and/or demonstrate financial need



Applicants must be prepared to fully engage in the Fidelity Scholars Program:

- Connecting with Fidelity
 mentors
- Attending College Success
 Coach meetings
- Participating in Fidelity Scholars virtual and in-person programs



This is a three hour per month commitment.



Process for Community College Partners



Submit Nomination Form

Community College partners identify students who will benefit and meet eligibility requirements on a rolling basis by July 11.



Support student finalists

UNCF will notify Community College Partners of students selected & communicate with them their application process.



Verify student enrollment

UNCF will notify Community College Partners students who have been selected to confirm their attendance.



Application Process for Nominees



Nominated students invited

UNCF will email nominated students an invitation-only link to complete the application process.



Submit application

Students to create a UNCF profile and complete the applications through secured link within 2 weeks of receipt of email invitation.

Complete video interview

Students who meet the eligibility requirements will be asked to complete a 15-minute interview
